The Barnes County Commission met in regular session on Tuesday, October 1, 2024, with Bill Carlblom, Cindy Schwehr, Vicky Lovell, Pete Paulson, and Shawn Olauson present. Chairman Bill Carlblom called the meeting to order at 8:00 a.m., roll call was taken, the Pledge of Allegiance was recited, and the agenda was reviewed.

### **Planning & Zoning**

Liz Roorda presented one variance for Bridgetown Builders on behalf of Roz Allyson. The application is for a setback variance of 60' from the center of the subdivision road located in Ashtabula Township 27-142-58, Lot 6 Block 2 in Werner Subdivision in Ashtabula Township, Parcel #03-650060 for the purpose of building a cabin. Cindy Schwehr made a motion to approve the variance; Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. The motion carried with all members voting yes.

## **Sheriff's Office**

Randy McClaflin and Shane Kalbrener presented a quote for the Sheriff's office remodeling in the courthouse from Jesse Vavra. Jesse quoted \$20,000 to \$26,000 and Ray Nelson quoted \$18,000 to \$20,000. Valley Lumber is the least expensive for materials. Bill Carlblom made a motion to move forward with Valley Lumber for materials and Ray Nelson for the labor. Shane, James, and Ryan will help Ray as much as they can, and Ray's charge will be adjusted reflecting our employee's help. Cindy Schwehr seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll call vote with all members voting yes.

#### **Barnes County Park**

The Park Board would like to purchase a JD Utility Tractor with a loader and grapple fork for \$41,150.00. It is in the budget for this year. This does not include the grooming mower. The park board did approve this purchase and are now awaiting the approval of the commission. It is needed to do work in the parks. Shawn Olauson made a motion to approve the purchase of the JD Utility Tractor with adding the mower attachment back into the package; the mower attachment is approximately \$3,400.00. Pete Paulson seconded the motion. Roll call vote was taken with all members voting yes. Overtime compensation was discussed for Scott Kohler for doing tree cleanup due to the ice damage that was done this spring for the emergency declaration. Cindy Schwehr made a motion to approve the overtime for Scott; Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. Motion carried with all members voting yes.

### **Highway Department**

Jamie Smith appeared before the commission to give an update on the activities of the Highway Department. City County Health District was at the Highway Department for the annual Flu immunizations. NDACO is awarding Kerry Johnson to the Hall of Honor at the upcoming NDACO Conference in October. DOT will be introducing new staff members. Jamie and Tim will attend the Regional Road Conference in Sioux Falls. She will present on how our Highway Department is run. Township billing for work and mowing is starting. The employees have been prepping the machinery for the snowfall season. Jamen sprayed the cattails in ditches. Employees will be working on patching until freeze up and are finishing up on the culverts. We will partner with the Park Department to prepare for winter and blow out water lines when ready. They will put millings on hills at Little Yellowstone. Jamie would also like to thank the Recorders Office for their help with a problem a prospective buyer of some land brought to her attention where a private dwelling sits partially on county property.

### **Auditor's Office**

Vicky Lovell moved to approve the September 17, 2024 minutes. Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll call vote. Vicky Lovell moved to approve the September 26, 2024 minutes with correction; Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Julie reported that an offer was made to fill the payroll position, and the offer was accepted pending approval of the background check and the drug and alcohol check. The office has been busy with election preparations and the bulk mailings of ballots has begun to go out.

## **Veteran Service Office**

Tammy Jacobson appeared to discuss the appointment scheduling for veterans and the van drivers. Currently the van driver does the scheduling of the veterans' appointments, and it works well. The board of commissioners feel that it is the duty of the office to do the scheduling, and the driver will not be doing the scheduling going forward. The board feels that the driver is part time and if the driver is on call 24/7, the driver may be putting too much time in to be considered part time and compensation may become an issue. It shouldn't have to be a 24/7 operation. Having more than two part time drivers was also discussed due to the difficulties of getting applicants for another driver. We may have to advertise the opening differently.

# **Environmental Services**

Shane Kalbrener presented the contract for the new boiler system from Martin Mechanical. Cindy Schwehr made a motion to proceed and approve the contract from Martin Mechanical. Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. The motion carried with Cindy, Bill, Shawn and Pete voting yes and Vicky Lovell voting no. Removal of the old jail concrete steps and wall was discussed to make room for parking spaces. The work would be done by Shane, James, and Ryan. Bill Carlblom moved to approve the removal of the steps and walls and ramp for new parking spaces. Pete Paulson seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll call vote with all members voting yes.

## **Commission Discussion**

Pete Paulson attended a Weed Board meeting last week. Purple Loosestrife in Potter Township has been an ongoing problem. A helicopter has sprayed the area. Jamen Windish purchased a combination eye wash shower station for \$1,200.00 which was approved by the Weed Board. Pete also updated the board members on the VSO office van mileage and office calls. Cindy Schwehr updated the commission board members on City County Health District providing school nurses and how much they charge the school. They are looking into what nursing options can be provided for \$16,000.00. The nurse costs approximately \$36,000 to \$40,000. Katie will meet with Josh Johnson on what can be done. Tommy Bergan is new on the CCHD board. CCHD is looking for a grant to fund a portable mobile unit to use in the Barnes County Communities. Vicky Lovell reported the library is finished inside and they are working on moving books back by October 16th. There will be a small celebration at the library on October 5th with some music. Vicky attended the Housing Authority meeting and the South Central Regional Council meeting.

## Final 2025 Budget

Cindy Schwehr moved to approve the 2025 budget at the refined budget of 11,799,372.20 or 121.45 mills; Pete Paulson seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll call vote with all members voting yes.
