Corrections

Jeremy Wolff discussed the PowerDMS Program. PowerDMS is software that helps keep up on policy and saves older policy versions, e-signatures availability, yearly reminders to update CPR and First Aid. One quote has the policy and training, and the other quote has the training portion only. \$21,000 for all three programs for two years; \$12,000 for two programs for two years. The discussion is tabled until January and more information is available.

Dispatch

Sarah Miller presented information on VHF Paging Equipment. The state is moving to the 800 megahertz. The state project will not be completed until approximately 2026. The concern is for the paging and siren aspect of the project. Tower areas in the county have valleys where the signals don't reach the pagers. Our VHF Equipment is outdated, and Motorola no longer provides service or support for it. The equipment is called Quantar. If it needs parts, they have to find them on E-Bay or take them off of old units. If we can't find parts, what do we do. We have to replace or transition to the 800 system which isn't ready. Quotes are to replace the Quantar with the new version called GTR. The quote is \$19,475 for replacing the repeater and \$975.00 for installation. Vicky Lovell made a motion to approve the purchase; Pete Paulson seconded the motion. Motion carried with all members voting yes.

Commission Discussion

Pete Paulson reported that the VSO has hired a part-time driver who will be starting this week. The \$15.00 state grant for rides will be ending this month. North Star Classic is this week. Vicky Lovell reported the library will host "Books are My Jam" fundraiser on December 7th and a Radiothon on December 10th to raise money for the roof project. Bill Carlblom will be attending an interview for a Highway Operator at the Highway Department. The Troubadours will be in concert at the courthouse on December 16th.
