Technician Report Jan/Feb 2020

- Parks and Recs Grant: Initial Environmental Clearance Review has been performed and now waiting on Grant Award Agreement between NDPRD and grantee (SCD). Money will be allocated, and we should be able to install restroom facilities this summer.
- Clausen Springs Dam Watershed 319 grant: Have developed a rough draft. Continue to chip away at it, but have several items that I will need to wait on in order to continue
 - Will receive Andre's water quality assessment and narrative later this summer (July?) that will dictate the direction of SCD's 319 proposal.
 Protection or Restoration? Results may be skewed again this summer due to excessive water.
 - Will attend PTMApp (Prioritize, Target and Measure) training in Jamestown on Feb 27th. This training will help me develop a budget by targeting priority areas and calculating the BMP's that will be most cost effective and efficient.
 - Need to finish field checks before I speculate on problems throughout watershed. If during field checks, we see a lot of erosion that could have been prevented with BMP's it will be easier to present a narrative and budget based on actual field data.
 - o Will meet one on one with local producers to address their concerns.

- 12 sites currently planned
- o 58,705ft planned
- 13,260 trees on order from LON, Towner and Big Sioux nurseries
