March 8th, 2021 Shelby Larson, Acting District Conservationist (DC)

I am currently the acting DC for the Valley City office. I am normally based out of the Jamestown Field Office. I will roughly be here until the end of April. I'm in the office typically 3 days a week. I am working mainly on getting the EQIP applications finished up and sent in.

Barnes County has 4 EQIP Applications. 2 are going forward with, one is pending eligibility yet, and the last one is going to wait till next years batching.

We have 1 person interested in applying for CSP, sent out the application.

Barnes County has 1 person interested in renewing their CSP Contract.

Cody is working on 6 different WRE's and roughly 4-10 Waterbank applications depending on who wants to continue with applying.

NRCS has a new employee who is going to be based out of the Valley City Field Office. Alex Wittenberg is now the agronomist for the Maple River CDU (Valley City, Finley, Fargo, and Hillsboro offices).

<u>Covid Update:</u> No board meetings in the office. Masks are require by all employees to wear full time when in the office. The NRCS/SCD is allowed to have 2 employees in the building and FSA is allowed to have 2 employees in the building at a time. Others are encourage to work at home. The offices are to set up rotations. The doors are closed to producers. However, we are allowed to do field work and have Box/OneSpan to utilize.
