

# July/Aug 2023 Tech Report

## Trees/Weed Barrier:

- May 17<sup>th</sup> First Day of tree planting.
- June 5<sup>th</sup> Finished Tree Planting. 2 Cancellations and several short sites.
- 86,050ft planted in 2023. Weed barrier installed on all.
- Finished weed barrier installation June 27<sup>th</sup>. Seasonal crew finished.
- Certified and completed all tree plans. Filled out all pay appts for OHF reimbursement and mailed to producers to sign and return on June 28th. All submitted on July 14th.
- OHF cost applications are currently being accepted until August 18. I have called 25 interested producers and so far have completed 12 tree plans totaling roughly 60,000ft.

#### Grass:

- June 30<sup>th</sup> started custom grass seeding around tree sites. Completed 7 sites.
- Have 5 sites left to do. Will dormant seed those later this fall. Producer opted to keep sites tilled until I seed grass.
- Routed 1590 grass drill to 15 sites so far (450 acres)
- Have multiple producers waiting for upcoming CRP grass seeding window Aug 10-25.

#### Other:

- June 6,2023-Ordered a load of gravel to Riparian Park to repair canoe launch. Installed portable kayak launch.
- July 6,2023-picked up 2 pallets of bentonite in Mandan.
- July 28-attended Area 2 SCD meeting in Ellendale.
