

The Barnes County Commission met in regular session on Wednesday, November 8, 2023 with Cindy Schwehr, Vicky Lovell, Bill Carblom, Pete Paulson, and Shawn Olauson present via teleconference. Chairman Carblom called the meeting to order at 9:15 a.m.

VC Schools Building Levy Error Update

At the November 7, 2023 meeting, the following was decided: "The overtaxed amount for tax years 2019, 2020, 2021 and 2022 will be refunded by the County, with coverage of costs (envelopes, checks, paper, postage, time and 1099s) to be determined between the school board and the Commission. Pete Paulson moved to authorize the plan and move forward; Cindy Schwehr seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with all members voting "yes"."

After further consideration, Pete Paulson moved to go with the original agreement between the school district and the County that the school district would reimburse the county for postage only, along with the tax dollars; Shawn Olauson seconded the motion. Motion carried upon roll-call vote, with Cindy Schwehr and Vicky Lovell voting "no".

With no further business, Pete Paulson made a motion, seconded by Shawn Olauson, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously, and the meeting was adjourned at 9:39 a.m.
