Trees

- ➤ All 2025 OHF contracts were funded. 4 producers cancelled their contracts. All producers who wanted to move forward have signed their contracts and plans have been funded/implemented.
- ➤ 2024 OHF reimbursement was received end of November \$54,500.
- > OHF Funding is questionable for 2026
- ➤ 14 tree plans currently finalized. Roughly 72,000ft. Waiting on several other tree plans to be finalized by landowners.
- > All current tree orders from Big Sioux and Towner have been verified.

Drill/Grass Seeding

- ➤ John Deere 1590 is stored for the year-Dormant seeding came too late for any producers to seed.
- > 1590 has was delivered to 25 sites this year.
- > 360 acres seeded

Other

- Shed/Cooler winterized and cleaned up. Well is drained
- ➤ 10ft chisel plow purchased from an estate sale. Picked up 11.14.24. Have started to upgrade/repair to make it portable and more functional for renters.
- > Grotberg Electric installed lighting in tree shed.
- > Attended annual convention in Bismarck on November 25-26th


