EQIP MBRI deadline was February 7th. Ranking was due February 14th. 3 applications, 1 was preapproved. I have completed the paperwork and waiting to get signatures and submit for review and approval of the contract.

Attended the Barnes County North School Career Fair, had a booth set up with educational information along with recruiting packets. We had 2 sets of soil aggregate stability tubes set up. This shows how chunks of tilled vs no-till soil samples hold up after being submersed in water

Cody and I attended the Valley City State University Career Fair on February 25th. We also had the aggregate stability tubes set up to display soil samples and the differences between no-till and tilled soils. We also spoke about different career opportunities with NRCS, Farm Bill Specialist, and the SCD. Had Jason's help wanted sign up for seasonal help. Handed out a few applications to college students.

Cody and I attended the SE Zone meeting on February 26th in Jamestown

❖ Trees:

- ➤ 19 tree plans currently finalized. Roughly 78,510ft. Up from 55,000ft last year.
- > Sending out Down Payment requests and Planting Agreements this week. Down payments totaling roughly \$30,000 (25%)
- ➤ OHF Funding is still questionable for 2026
- ➤ Listed for seasonal help on our Facebook, Website, Newsletter and with Janna Kohler, Director for Career Services at VCSU. 2 applications so far.

Pickup discussion:

- > Have both pickups up for bids on SCD website.
- > Feb 24th ordered new pickup from Puklich per board discussion.
- > Had yet to be built may be 8 weeks or more.
- > Ordered new topper from Berts. Painted to match pickup 3-4 weeks.

Other:
